

Stone China Mark S3

This is another rare transfer printed mark, usually in **blue**, but very rarely in **black**, noted on patterns 9 to 17.

As it only occurs on very low pattern numbers a date of about 1815 to 1825 seems most likely.



There appear to be at least three size variations, 19, 25 and 28mm in diameter. (To those who remember: $\frac{3}{4}$ ", 1" and $1\frac{1}{8}$ " in diameter.)

Sadly the one example of the mark in black (bottom right) does not bear a pattern number.
