A common impressed mark used on transfer printed and enamelled medium quality earthenwares between the early 1870s and the close in 1887.

Printed pattern names often accompany this mark.

Most items seem to be dinner wares or display plates, but few items seem to have been special orders or commemorative plates, such as that bottom right with an Italian name on the front (obtained from the USA).
