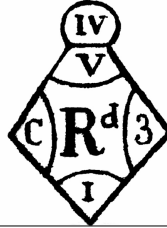


## Porcelain Mark P15

The printed registration mark is fairly uncommon. It was printed overglaze on good quality well gilded wares in one of the main decoration colours, usually **blue**, but more rarely **red** or **brown**.



The earliest porcelain design shapes were registered in 1849 with the last being in 1883 when the registration system changed.
